# The Dunamis Fellowship

## What is it?

The purpose of the Dunamis Fellowship is to mobilize, equip and deploy Spirit-empowered witnesses for Jesus Christ. It is a unique combination of a missionary society, a seminary faculty, and an intentional prayer community that enables us to meet the challenges of working for renewal and advancing the Gospel in the world today.

It is a *missionary society* in that a group of people are charged with a common vision of fulfilling the Great Commission. Members of the society teach, preach, and witness to the gospel throughout the world. The primary method of engagement in missions is through short term teaching missions that equip leaders for participation in the worldwide movement of the Holy Spirit.

It is a *seminary faculty* in that individuals are equipped for ministry through teachers who present the biblical and theological foundations of ministry. The Dunamis Fellowship has three dynamic teaching elements: (1) systematic teaching that is biblical and reformed, (2) "lab time" - intentionally moving from theory and teaching into practice of whatever is being taught, and (3) "debriefing" - rigorously paying attention to what the Holy Spirit is doing in our midst and learning to cooperate with the Holy Spirit.

It is an *intentional prayer community* in that the life and work of the Fellowship is grounded in prayer. The prayers of the members will be led by the Holy Spirit. Through prayer we grow in intimacy with God, receive anointing for ministry, and open doors for advancing the gospel.

It is assumed that all members of the Dunamis Fellowship will assist in building the spiritual, organizational, and financial support base of the Fellowship, in order to help PRMI fulfill its vision.

## The Basic Tenets

Based on the commands of Jesus, the tenets provide us with a common vision that flows from the heart of God, creating the gift of fellowship that comes as Christians walk together in obedience to Jesus. Membership involves an annual commitment to these tenets. Items one to six commit to growing in relationship with God. Items seven to ten direct one toward relationship with other members of the Fellowship and of the Church of Jesus Christ. These tenets provide the basis for our unity which is centred in Jesus Christ.

### I commit myself to:

- 1 Growing in intimacy with Jesus Christ who is the way, the truth and the life and the only way to God, the Father.
- 2 Growing in the Word of God as my authority
- 3 Fulfilling the Great Commission
- 4 Receiving the Holy Spirit according to Acts 1:8
- 5 Doing the work of prayer that shapes the future
- 6 Listening to the Holy Spirit and walking in obedience
- 7 "Walking in the light" with other members of the Body of Jesus Christ
- 8 Working with others to accomplish the purpose of the Dunamis Fellowship—to mobilize, equip, and deploy Spirit-empowered witnesses for Jesus Christ.
- 9 Nurturing other members of the Dunamis Fellowship in their following of Jesus Christ
- 10 Participating in and seeking to build up the congregation to which God has called me

## PRMI Vision Statement
